

**Data protection information sheet
for Wieland Austria Ges.m.b.H. suppliers
pursuant to Article 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”)**

Wieland Austria Ges.m.b.H. (hereinafter referred to as “WAG”) will provide information below for its suppliers about the collection of their personal data (all information that relates directly or indirectly to you and either identifies you or makes it possible to identify you) and how it is processed. This data protection information sheet is intended for our existing and future suppliers.

1. Data processing in connection with supplier management

Purpose:

Contact data from our suppliers (such as first name, surname, company, contact person, e-mail address) will be stored and processed for the purpose of initiating and conducting the business relationship. In addition, supplier data is processed for the following purposes: Maintenance of a supplier list, exchange of contact data with suppliers, documentation of supplier audit reports, documentation and analysis of supplier evaluations and complaints, ordering freight wagons and preparing bills of lading. This also includes conducting and archiving communication/correspondence associated with these activities.

Legal basis:

- Contract performance (Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR);
- Compliance with a legal obligation (Art. 6(1)(c) GDPR);
- Pursuit of legitimate interests (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR), whilst smooth and efficient business processes in relation to our suppliers would not be possible, or only to a very limited extent, without processing this data.

Recipients:

- Contractual and business partners
- parent company (Wieland Group)

1. Recipients outside the EEA

Some of these recipients may be located outside the EEA or may process personal data outside the EEA. The level of data protection in other countries may not correspond to the prevailing standard with the EEA. Accordingly, WAG has implemented measures to ensure that all recipients provide an adequate level of data protection. For example, we conclude standard contractual clauses to this end (2010/87/EC and/or 2004/915/EC).

2. Retention period

As a rule, personal data is retained until the termination of the contractual relationship or until the expiration of the applicable statutory limitation and retention periods or for longer periods through the termination of any legal disputes in which the data is required as evidence.

3. Additional information requirements under Article 13 GDPR

- Rights of data subjects:
Suppliers have a right to request from WAG access to and rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing concerning the data subject and to object to processing as well as the right to data portability; Furthermore, suppliers have the right to lodge complaints with the supervisory authority (in Austria, the data protection authority based in Vienna).
- When collecting data, WAG will provide notice should the provision of personal data by the supplier concerned be required by law or contract or should it be necessary for the conclusion of a contract. At the same time, WAG will provide notice whether the supplier concerned is obliged to provide its personal data and of the potential consequences of failing to provide this data.
